## Rules & Regulations

- Entrants must be between the ages of 12-15. Each entrant is limited to three (3) pieces of artwork.
- All artwork must be the original work of the entrant. All artwork must be matted or framed, and must be labeled on the back with the artist's name and the title of the artwork. Artwork can be no bigger than 20" x 20" x 20".
- Video entries should not run longer than five minutes and should contain captions for the hearing impaired. Video submissions must be submitted via email to Samantha Noll at [snoll@aclib.us](mailto:snoll@aclib.us). Please include the title of the video and artist's name in the email. Videos can be sent as an mp4 or QuickTime file or can be uploaded to Youtube.
- Any videos containing music that belongs to someone else may be muted when/if they are shared on the library's website or other social media sites.
- Entries will be accepted no earlier than 9:30 am Friday, September 13, 2019 and no later than 5:00 pm Friday, October 11, 2019. Artwork may be submitted to any Alachua County Library District branch.
- All entries **must** be accompanied by a completed *Entry Form* signed by the artist and by the artist's parent/legal guardian as well. (This *Entry Form* will serve as a liability waiver and as a release allowing the Library to use and/or display the artist's work in the library and on the website.)
- All artwork will be displayed in Meeting Room A of the Headquarters Library, 401 East University Avenue, Gainesville, Florida, on October 19-20, 2019. Winning artwork will be displayed through November 2019 in the Teen Space of the Headquarters Library. All artwork should be picked up by December 15, 2019 or will be forfeited.
- A reception and award ceremony will take place at 1 pm on Saturday October 19, at the Headquarters Library.
- Prizes will be given for the following: 1st, 2nd and 3rd Place with four Honorable Mentions, Best Logo, Crowd Favorite, and four category winners. Decisions of the judges are final.
- Anyone can vote for the Crowd Favorite award while the artwork is displayed on October 19th-20th. Crowd Favorite will be announced via the website, [www.aclib.us/teens](http://www.aclib.us/teens).
