- Entrant must be 18 years or older
- Each entrant is limited to two (2) pieces of artwork
- All artwork must be the original work of the entrant.
- Artwork may be submitted as a digital photo or digitized drawing.
- Please submit artwork as a jpeg, png, or pdf. Resolution should be at least 300 dpi and file size no larger than 10 mb.
- Entries will be accepted no earlier than 9:30 am **Thursday, July 1, 2021** and no later than 8 p.m. **Thursday, July 29, 2021**. Artwork may be submitted by email to Cheri Carpenter via email at ccarpenter@aclib.us.
- All entries **must** be accompanied by a completed *Entry Form* signed by the artist. (This *Entry Form* will serve as a release allowing the Library to use and/or display the artist's work on the library website, on the library's social media pages and YouTube channel)
- Artwork will be displayed on the library's website.
- A virtual art demonstration will take place to kick off the art show in early August.
